





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UIP: REPRESENTING THE PHLEBOLOGY WORLD SINCE 1959

Dear vein-lymphatic colleagues and patients,

Not by coincidence we chose the April Newsletter to announce the UIP branding enhancement project. On March 24 we celebrated all together the 65th anniversary of the same UIP.

Therefore, after a present in which we just celebrated the past, this becomes the perfect time to look at the future of this Organization, starting from where we are now.

The UIP was founded by four European societies on March 24,1959: a time in which being "**international"** was a more than significant achievement.

Nowadays UIP represents **81 scientific societies from ALL continents**, positioning the Organization as "THE" Worldwide reference for proper vein AND lymphatic care. Advocacy for both healthcare professionals and patients is among the main aims of the UIP and, in this context, facilitating the Institutions and the Governments in understanding immediately the dimensions of our organization is of pivotal importance.



For this and all the other reasons you will find in the dedicated video available by a <u>CLICK HERE</u>, the Executive Committee approved the upgrade of the name from "**International Union of Phlebology**" (UIP) to "World Union of International Phlebo-lymphology" (WUIP), together with the upgraded logo whose detailed description is available in the same tutorial linked above. The branding enhancement will become operative after the General Council approval. Meanwhile, we remain at your full disposal. Indeed, UIP will keep on starting with "U" or, to better state, with double "U", meaning that it's our hope everyone will reach

out to at least another one in the vein-lymphatic community, in order to promote synergy and advancement, not just at an "international" rather **"world"** level.

VEIN WEEK 2024 REPORT



April 1-7, 2024

On April 1-7, all the vein-lymphatic world celebrated Vein Week.

The initiative developed by venous-lymphatic World International Network foundation (<u>https://wwinfoundation.com/vw/</u>) with the aim to increase public vein-lymphatic awareness and to enhance global synergy among the different scientific societies and experts comes to its fourth edition.

We'd like to congratulate all the pro-active ones who developed and attended initiatives, moreover developing synergy among different societies and countries.

Of special notice, the engagement of new countries previously not involved, demonstrating a constant global growth of the related public vein-lymphatic awareness.

The five main RESULTS of the Vein Week 2024 project were:

- 1. Direct engagement of 168 project developers.
- 2. Development of 123 events in one week.
- 3. Engagement of ALL continents, including previously silent regions.
- 4. In 7 days, 351.312 visualizations of the events uploaded in the VEIN WEEK MAP, with 306,19 GB shared.
- 5. Together with many others, among the developed institutional interactions, of particular importance were the ones with Italian Board of Physicians, the UK parliament group for venous-lymphatic disease, the Paraguay Ministry of Health, the International Society of Orthopaedic Surgery & Trauma, the European College of OBGyn, the Indonesia Ministry of Health.

Next year vein week will be celebrated on April 7-13 as it is always developed around April 7 (World Health Day) in order to remind the world that there is no proper healthcare without vein-lymphatic care: a significant chance to demonstrate that **"every week is vein week".**

"Learning from the past, looking at the future"

It's an honor for me to write the speaker's editorial.

I am **Nicolas Néaume,** an interventional vascular physician at the Pasteur Clinic in Toulouse, France. I have been elected President of the **French Society of Phlebology** for the period from 2023 to 2026.

I am delighted to be at the head of the oldest phlebology society in the world (founded in 1947), which was behind the creation of the **International Union of Phlebology** in 1959, and whose 65th anniversary we are celebrating this year.

For all these years, the French Society of Phlebology has been involved in sharing and transmitting phlebology through training, annual national congresses, and participation in numerous international congresses. At the same time, the SFP promotes the clinical research needed to improve the quality of care.

The transmission of knowledge comes to us from our former colleagues, and it is our turn to transmit it to all our colleagues in Phlebology, but above all to our young colleagues who are the future of our profession, and also to all our colleagues whose access to information and sharing is still difficult for economic or even language reasons. And it is in this respect that I would like to remind you that we are committed at the SFP, through my representation in the UIP's EWG:

- to develop more and more interactions with geographical areas such as Africa, where many countries speak our French language.
- helping them to raise their voices and be heard.
- by offering them the opportunity to submit their ideas, documents, research, or videos in French to us, and we will translate them for them.
- with our support for international conferences.
- giving them a voice within the speaker's corner and the EWG.

This commitment is in keeping with the tradition of SFP and UIP, on the way to new adventures.

UIP SOCIETIES: Past, Present & Future

Pan American Society of Phlebology and Lymphology



In 1950 the International Society of Angiology was born and in 1952, under the presidency of Dr. Alfonso Albanese, the First Latin American Congress of Angiology was held in Buenos Aires. Other Angiology Societies were beginning to be formed in the region in the 60's, as well as the Latin American Angiology Chapter. However, colleagues from different countries were already beginning to create societies that focused exclusively on venous and lymphatic diseases.

In 1981, during the IV Argentine Congress of Phlebology and Lymphology, held in Buenos Aires, Prof. Dr. Edgardo Altmann Canestri, in view of the massive presence of phlebologists from America, with his mark of camaraderie and friendship, proposed the creation of a scientific community that would reflect the thinking of our continent.

At the beginning, under the name of **Pan-American Chapter of Phlebology and Lymphology,** this scientific brotherhood was born with the integration of the Societies of Phlebology and Lymphology of **Argentina** (Dr. Edgardo Altmann-Canestri), **Brazil** (Dr. Laudenor Pereira Da Silva), **Colombia** (Dr. Abraham Lechter), **Paraguay** (Dr. Aguero Wagner), **Peru** (Dr. Luis del Aguila Hoyos) and **Ecuador** (Dr. Augusto Diaz Bautista). Prof. Dr. Edgardo Altmann Canestri was appointed Founding President and it was decided that the venue for the first scientific event would be in Argentina.

Thus, in 1983, the **1st Pan-American Congress of Phlebology and Lymphology** was held in the city of Tucumán, Argentina, in conjunction with the 5th Argentine Congress of Phlebology and Lymphology, and the next academic event is scheduled for three years from now.

In 1986, during the 2nd Pan-American Congress in the city of Bogota (Colombia), it was decided to continue with the congresses in the different venues every 2 years.

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In November 1990, during the Congress of Bahia (Brazil), the name of the Society was changed, definitively establishing the **PAN-AMERICAN SOCIETY OF PHLEBOLOGY AND LYMPHOLOGY.** By this date, the Societies of **Cuba**, **Uruguay**, **Venezuela and Martinique** had already joined the Society.

In 1991 the first issue of the **REVISTA PANAMERICANA DE FLEBOLOGIA Y LINFOLOGIA** appeared, directed by Prof. Drs. César F. Sánchez and Edgardo Altmann-Canestri, which would later be edited by the **Fundación Flebológica Argentina** under the supervision of Prof. Dr. Úrsula Tropper and Dr. Sergio Garbarz, honorary member of the Society and Medical Director of the Fundación Flebológica Argentina.

From then on and until today, many countries such as **Chile, El Salvador, Mexico, Dominican Republic, Bolivia, USA, Guatemala, Spain and Canada** will be incorporated.


