SEPTEMBER-DECEMBER 2023 UIP ACTIONS

Since the last General Council meeting of September 2023, the following main actions have been taken.

UIP CONTRACTS REVISION

All UIP contracts with different services providers have been reviewed with the aim of optimizing their performance and cost-effectiveness, in protection of UIP members interests.

UIP MONTH 24 project development

Creation of a fixed video-call appointment open to all member Societies, but also to all the vein-lymphatic community and the population with the aim of opening the UIP doors to whoever is willing to deliver comments, needs, moral and productive criticism on how to advance at best in vein-lymphatic advocacy and patient-care.



UIP 4 pillars

Creation of the basis to produce 4 scientific documents of appropriateness in superficial and deep venous management, conservative approaches and vascular malformation treatment.

UIP Working Groups

Creation of 4 Working Groups dedicated to **Academic & Institutions Reach-out**, **Multispecialty interaction**, **Public Vein-lymphatic Awareness**, **Advocacy**.

UIP MOU

Memorandum Of Understanding documents have been prepared to establish permanent synergy among UIP and other International Organization of potentially synergistic specialties.

SEPTEMBER-DECEMBER 2023 UIP ACTIONS

UIP Brand Positioning & Naming

The International Union of Phlebology was founded on March 24, 1959 by the 4 Societies of Phlebology of Benelux, France, Germany and Italy. Sixty-five years ago, being "International" was quite a unique and outstanding achievement for Scientific Societies dedicated to vein-care. In the modern globalized world, after more than 6 decades, the "international" branding is not able to immediately communicate the "WORLD" wide nature of an Organization counting today 81 Scientific Societies from all continents. The Executive committee majority proposes to enhance the UIP naming by adding a "W" to the acronym (WUIP) in order to indicate the World Union of International Phlebo-lymphology. A detailed rebranding project presentation will be submitted in the next few months".

Science & Education

The Scientific and Educational Committees have been formed and new interesting projects are going to be submitted soon to the Executive Committee for final approval.



Congress Committee

In the next few weeks the Committee will submit the new features for the UIP World Congresses to the Executive Committee for its final approval. Top Scientific and Educational quality, together with inclusiveness will represent the pillars of this new proposal.

UIP 4 PILLARS

2023-2027 International Union of Phlebology (UIP) Four Pillars project sum-up

AIM: during the elections campaign, the UIP president committed to create four documents on phlebo-lymphology **appropriateness** on the topics of.

1. Diagnostics

(First Author (FA) Fedor Lurie)

2. Superficial Venous Disease Procedures

(FA Nuttawut Sermsathanasawadi)

3. Deep Venous management

(FA Mark Garcia)

4. Conservative vein-lymphatic management

(FA Sergio Gianesini)

Venous-lymphatic malformation topic has been already covered by an ongoing updated of a previous UIP consensus under the leadership of prof. BB Lee that will be submitted to the attention of the UIP Executive Committee (EC) for drafting, revision and approval.

DEVELOPMENT PLAN

UIP President, in conjunction with the Scientific Committee Chair, will supervise the project, guaranteeing:

- 1. Top scientific level.
- **2. All EC members authorship inclusion,** in representation of the General Council who voted for them.
- **3. Coordination** among the four different documents.
- 4. Geographical & Multi-specialty representation.

UIP 4 PILLARS

The 4 documents will follow the timeline reported herein:



Authors must be of undoubtful scientific value and they must have already published at least 5 scientific works on vein-lymphatic topics in journals with an IF > 1.5. A review group will be acknowledged in the publication and it will include all UIP Scientific Committee who took part in the work and one representative per UIP member society, in order to guarantee global representativeness. The first author of each document is selected by the UIP Executive Committee and she/he will be also in charge of proposing the co-author list to the same EC for approval.

SPEAKER'S CORNER

Connecting the continent, Welcoming the World...while Engaging with all the UIP.

The UIP Engagement Working Group (EWG) was formed with the aim of opening the doors of the UIP to pro-active professionals, in representation of geographical (members from all continents) and gender equality. New generations collaborate with top experts in the EWG, so fostering vital synergy.

Currently the EWG is in its second term and it had its second in-person session during the UIP Miami World Congress. Every World congress hosts indeed a dedicated EWG session, where showcasing the accomplished missions, while interacting with the audience regarding the ongoing and potentially to be developed projects.

The opening of the session was led by the current President- of the UIP, prof. Sergio Gianesini and the Chair of the EWG Dr. Juan Chunga Prieto, who summed up vision and mission of the different projects, while stimulating the audience to get interactice with the UIP. Then, EWG members dove into the projects details, following a continental representation. Dr. Nathalia Cardoso, representative of Latin America presented the "UIPodcast" project, dedicated to digital interaction involving top experts . Dr. Jesús Arriaga, representative of North America, presented the "Questions and Answers with

patients" project, dedicated to stimulate patient awarenss. Dr. Nicholas Neaume, representative of Europe, presented the project "Raise your voice" to stimulate proactive attitude in the vein-lymphatic community and finally, but not for importance, the representative of Asia, Dr. Takahiro Imai, presented the project "A day in the life", in which Phlebology everyday practice is showcased to the audience, also to stimulate appropriate practice.

After the presentations, the public was eager to take part in both the EWG and the related projects. A major issue the audience raised is the language barrier: UIP took note and is already exploring AI systems to always facilitate communication. Colleagues from the United States suggested that UIP focuses on public vein awareness, with a special focus on what phlebology is. This is a topic already included in the ongoing discussion of an eventual more contemporary new UIP name, including not only the world "Phlebology" but also "Veln", indeed with the aim of explaining the "Phlebology" world meaning. Last but not least, from Latin America, a target on Family Medicine was recommended.

It was a session full of camaraderie and motivation on the part of all participants.



UIP month 24



On behalf of all the International Union of Phlebology, I'd like to deeply thank all the ones who joined live or on demand last **December 24,** in the occasion of the **UIProject "Month 24".** Every 24 of the month, in honor of March 24, 1959, date in which UIP was founded, UIP opens its doors by means of a dedicated zoom, at 10 am NYC (4 pm Rome, 10 pm Bnagkok). The initiative provides the opportunity to explore how the UIP can serve at best the real necessities of the Phlebo-Lymphology world: in fact, the video conference call is open to whoever would like to provide her/his vision, needs, ideas

and even **criticism**, as long as productive and expressed in an appropriate tone. During the December 24 call the following important topics where discussed: 1) under-served areas reach-out 2) thrombotic risk awareness in the lymphology community 3) vein awareness in young public as per the Global Thrombosis Forum initiative 4) UIP 2025 Buenos Aires World Congress update 5) UIP 2027 Tblisi World Congress update. We have been honored by the spontaneous attendance of prof. Caprini who needs no introduction as top world-renowned figure in the vascular community. We have all being inspired by his opening and closing remark and we would like to highlight the many educational tools available in his website (https://capriniriskscore.org/tag/caprini-score/). The initiative has also provided the chance to present the highlights of what UIP has done in the last month. Among many other actions, the creation of a webpage entitled UIPro 2024 (http://www.uip-phlebology.org/UIPro2024) in which all the vein community can upload wishes for the 2024 (phlebolymphology world): rather than just "best wishes for 2024", UIP kindly ask the community to express specific wishes suggesting how to improve the phlebo-lymphology world. The call has been also the chance to deliver the best wishes from the UIP in a social way, by means of the **U..I..Play Music** project: vein experts from all around the world, recording together songs to be played live during the UIP events gala dinners. The initiative aims to foster teambuilding among international colleagues, therefore paving the way for synergy also in the educatio-






